- **Techniques in Dip Pen and Ink**
 - Styrofoam plate for mixing ink
 - Water cup
 - Small bottle of black ink
 - Pen holder
 - 107 nib
 - Small round watercolor brush
 - A few sheets of 9 X 12 watercolor paper
 - A few sheets of 9 X 12 Bristol paper
- **From Photo to Drawing for Beginners**
 - Charcoal vine and compressed charcoal
 - One (1) HB charcoal pencil
 - Pencils — 4B, 2B, HB
 - Conte crayons, ([example](#))
 - One (1) chamois
 - One (1) medium rubber eraser
 - One (1) medium kneaded eraser
 - Several sheets of 9x12 toned paper ([example](#))
 - Several sheets of 9 x12 white drawing paper, minimum 80 lb. ([example](#))
 - (Optional) larger toned sheets drawing paper, 18x 24
 - (Optional) large drawing board

- **Peace of Art**
 - Paper plate
 - Q-tips
 - One paintbrush (used; able to throw away)
 - Mod Podge (dimensional magic)
 - Glue stick, glue, or mod podge
 - Rectangle plaque or cardboard (cut to round or rectangle shape)
 - Beads, sequins, ribbon, and glitter
 - Magazines
 - Stick on gems
 - Round magnets for backing (optional)
 - Jewelry (old earrings) or charms (optional)
