- The following acrylic paint colors: cadmium yellow hue or Blickcrylic deep yellow; cadmium red hue or Blickcrylic fire red; alizarin crimson or Blickcrylic magenta; ultramarine blue; zinc or titanium white; raw or burnt umber
- Filbert or flat brush – at least 1/2"
- Filbert or flat brush – at least 1/4"
- Small Round brush for details
- Paint palette, Styrofoam plate, or wax paper taped to sturdy cardboard
- Water cup
- Paper towels
- Color wheel
- Paper and pencil for thumbnail drawings
